



Empowering the public with vital dengue prevention tips



Together we can stop dengue – spreading words for a healthier future

Red Ribbon Club of Tecnia Institute of Advanced Studies, New Delhi organized a campaign on Dengue in Bhalswa Dairy village on 29<sup>th</sup> October 2022. The institution has adopted five villages is continuously working to create awareness on human developmental issues. As part of this campaign, the RRC program officers Dr. Sheenu Arora and Dr. Rajnesh Kumar Pandey along with their students talked with individuals of the village.

The session began with the briefing of the lifecycle of mosquitoes and how they act as carriers of the dengue virus. Participants were made aware of the key symptoms of dengue fever, such as high fever, severe headaches, and body aches. The expert stressed the importance of early detection and treatment to reduce the risks of severe complications.

The session then transitioned into a practical activity, where students and community members, under the supervision of faculty, toured the village to identify potential mosquito breeding sites. Areas like stagnant water in drains, flowerpots, old tires, and water containers were inspected. Participants were taught how to prevent mosquitoes from breeding by eliminating standing water and maintaining cleanliness around homes and public areas.

During this hands-on activity, villagers actively participated in cleaning up areas prone to mosquito breeding. They also learned how to use simple methods like covering water containers, using mosquito repellents, and planting natural repellents like neem and citronella plants around their homes.

The session also included a demonstration on how to use insecticides safely and effectively to control mosquito populations in outdoor spaces. The use of mosquito nets and other protective measures was discussed to safeguard family members from being bitten, especially during peak mosquito activity times.

To ensure that the knowledge gained would be retained and spread further, participants were encouraged to share their learnings with neighbors and other family members. Additionally, pamphlets were distributed with clear instructions
