

1. Review of agendas of previous meeting

2. Grievances:

Grievance 1: Water cooler leakage on the 3rd floor.

Complainant: Arnav Sharma, BBA, 1st Year.

Details: A student of BBA reported that the water cooler located on the 3rd floor is leaking, causing water to accumulate on the floor, which poses inconvenience to students. The issue requires immediate attention.

Action Taken: The committee acknowledged the complaint and directed Admin Officer to inspect and resolve the issue at the earliest. A follow-up will be conducted to ensure the problem is rectified promptly.

Grievance 2: Air Conditioner not functioning properly in Room No. 1409. Complainant: Nikita Rana, MBA, 1st Year.

Details: A student of MBA reported that the Air Conditioner in Room No. 1409, 4th Floor, PG Building is not working efficiently, resulting in inadequate cooling and discomfort during classes.

Action Taken: The grievance was acknowledged, and the maintenance team was immediately informed to inspect and repair the air conditioner. A timeline for resolution was requested, and a follow-up will be conducted to confirm the completion of the repair work.

At the end, the Chairperson thanked all members for their active participation and emphasized the importance of timely implementation of the discussed action points.

Dr. Monisha opened the meeting with a warm welcome to all attendees and provided an overview of the agenda, emphasizing the importance of the topics to be discussed.

- 1: Review of activities conducted/planned for the academic year 2023-24:
 - The committee reviewed the events conducted as well as planned activities.

Executed Activity:

Poster Making on Girl Child: The activity was successfully conducted on 25th August, 2023 with the aim to understand the challenges faced by the girl child cultivates empathy and to analyze complex issues related to gender inequality.



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Planned Activities:

- Gender Sensitization Workshop: In order to develop a deeper understanding of genderrelated issues and to critically analyze gender stereotypes.
- ii. Competition on the Role of Media in Women Empowerment: With the objective of Gender Equality and Women's Empowerment within the community and redefining gender roles by allowing them to pursue their goals more freely.
- iii. Activity on Women's Rights and Empowerment with the view to provide the students a deeper understanding of the challenges women face in professional environments, including biases, stereotypes, and systemic barriers.
- Awareness regarding Women Health and Reproductive Rights in order to expand consciousness amongst young girls on Hygiene.
- Seminar on Women Mental Health for providing knowledge about various mental health disorders, such as anxiety, depression, and stress-related condition to girls.

The members discussed the planned activities, focusing on their execution and potential outcomes. Key implications were analyzed to ensure alignment with objectives and address anticipated challenges

- 2: Initiatives to spread awareness among students about the ICC and its role.
 - The committee suggested increasing awareness among students about the processes for reporting sexual harassment and promoting a safer environment.
 - Members were concerned regarding less display of messages concerned with women in the Institute. They emphasized to have posters & displays of members of ICC at various locations in the campus.
- 3: Grievance Received: Verbal Abuse Complaint

Issue Reported: Mr. Bharat, a BBA 2nd-year student, lodged a complaint concerning an issue of verbal abuse among students occurring in February 2024. The abusive behavior included derogatory remarks, insults, and threats, impacting both academic and social interactions.

Impact: The incident created a distressing atmosphere, leading to emotional distress, reduced academic engagement, and a heightened sense of insecurity on campus.

Actions Taken: The committee initiated an investigation, interviewing involved parties and collecting evidence to address the allegations of verbal abuse.

Support Services: ICC coordinated with the counselor to offer support services and provide resources for affected students to manage emotional distress effectively.

4: Closing Remarks: The chairperson thanked the members for their valuable contributions and insights. The meeting was adjourned at 11:45 am.

Actions Taken:

1. Air Conditioner in Room 1409:

- o The AC unit has been repaired and is now fully operational.
